

Great success for CHINAPLAS 2010 with over 80,000 visitors

The 24th International Exhibition on Plastics and Rubber Industries (also known as CHINAPLAS 2010) which concluded on April 22 at the Shanghai New International Expo Centre, Shanghai, attracted a total of 81,435 trade visitors from 136 countries and regions. Among them, 14,701 visitors were overseas buyers, accounting for 18.1% of the total.

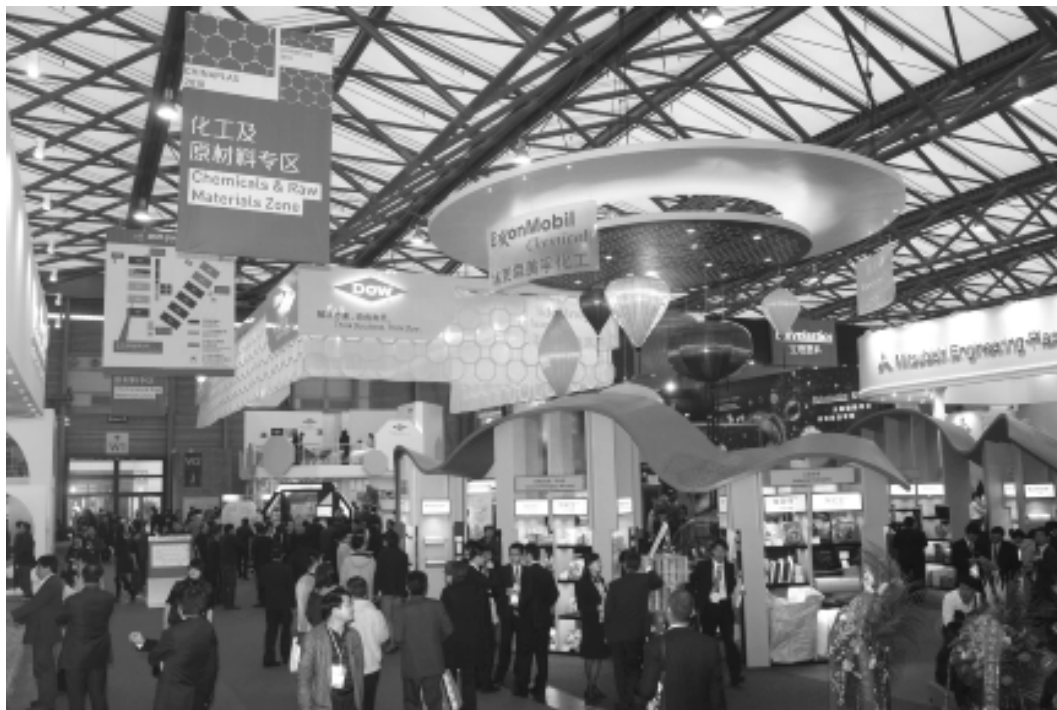
The show also received tremendous support by buyer groups organized by local associations. The staging of CHINAPLAS would also help the domestic enterprises to
